OWN IT | WEEK 2

BOTTOM LINE

YOU CAN OWN MONEY, BUT IT DOESN'T HAVE TO OWN YOU.

SCRIPTURE

"The earnings of the godly enhance their lives, but evil people squander their money on sin" (Proverbs 10:16 NLT).

"No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money" (Matthew 6:24 NIV).

GOAL OF SMALL GROUP

To help students understand that money isn't powerful. It's neutral. Our *perspective* of money is what gives money its power.

THINK ABOUT THIS

Leaders — When students hear "generosity," they often think of big giving campaigns. Encourage your students to follow through on small acts of generosity this week with their time, words, and money.

SAY THIS

- 7. What's one way you can be generous this week?
