# **SCRIPTURE**

"Very truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!" (John 8:58 NIV).

### **GOAL OF SMALL GROUP**

To help students understand that if what Jesus claimed about Himself is true, then everything Jesus said should be taken seriously.

### THINK ABOUT THIS

Leaders — Most students learn in a variety of ways, not just through listening. That means it can be helpful to bring in visual elements, movement, and other strategies to your small group room. This week, as a conversation starter, show a few images of Jesus that you find online to get students talking.

### SAY THIS

### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Describe what Jesus looks like in pictures or paintings that you've seen.
- 2. How do the people around you talk about and describe Jesus?
- 3. Who has shaped your view of Jesus the most? Parents? Church leaders? Friends? Yourself?
- 4. If Jesus IS God, how does that affect the way we see everything He did and said?
- 5. Did something you heard today change the way you think about who Jesus is? If so, what?
- 6. What's one way you can follow Jesus' example this week? (Leaders read this list about Jesus and encourage your students to pick one to focus on.)
  - He had a compassionate heart.
  - He was kind to the lowest people socially.
  - He was constantly giving.
  - He loved unlovable people.
  - He treated people with acceptance.
  - He was submissive to authority.
  - He forgave people who wronged him.
  - He spent time with God.
  - He didn't leverage his power for personal gain.
